



AKIA Publication Award

AKIA seeks to recognize an AKIA member with outstanding achievements in 2022, by conferring a publication award with a plaque and cash prize.

Award nomination: Regular AKIA members can nominate themselves or other AKIA members to the AKIA award committee. The nominee should be a current AKIA member. The nominee should be a Korean, Korean-American, or Korean-Canadian, who published papers in 2022 on any topics related to immunology. The award committee may identify and nominate candidates, if necessary.

Awardee selection and announcement: The awardee will be selected by the AKIA publication award committee. The selection will be based on a potential impact of the paper in a given field. Only the papers that were published between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022 will be considered for this award. All AKIA members eligible for this award, but a priority will be given to AKIA members at Assistant Professor level. Award announcement will be made in April 2023.

Nomination should include the following:

- The candidate's curriculum vitae
- PDF copy of the publication
